### Qualification for Admittance

Our Qualifications for Admittance includes:

- ❑ Open to 14 –21 year old young men and women.
- ❑ Prospective Candidates should have one of the following:
  - Strong interest in Military or Civilian Aviation
  - Desire to enter into one of the U.S. Military Service Academies, a College ROTC Program, or Military Enlistment after High School
  - Goal of attaining a Private Pilot's License.
- ❑ Possess good or above average academic grades.
- ❑ Recruit Officer Candidate must be of good moral character.
- ❑ Individuals must visit the unit and talk with the Recruiting Officer. Individuals must attend a Unit Orientation with at least one (preferably both) parent or guardian.
- ❑ Fill out all appropriate paperwork, and schedule an Interview.
- ❑ Pass a rigorous screening process very similar to the process used by the American Military Service Academies (including two board interviews by Officers of the Squadron).
- ❑ Officer Candidates must pass a background check.
- ❑ If accepted, report for duty at the next class processing date for Induction Day, for 15-week Officer Candidate School.
